Sep 02 2022 The study, "Technology's Edge: The Educational Benefits of Computer-Aided Instruction," examined whether the "I CAN Learn"[R] computer-based curriculum is more effective than traditional classroom instruction at teaching pre-algebra and algebra concepts to middle- and high-school students. The study included about 1,600 students in 15 high schools and two middle schools in three large urban school districts. The research described in this article is consistent with What Works Clearinghouse (WWC) evidence standards. WWC indicates the strengths include: The study is a well-implemented randomized controlled trial. However, they caution that the study's main results rely on a 30-item pre-algebra and algebra test developed for use in this study. The authors do not provide

information about how well the test questions measured students' knowledge of the concepts taught. In addition, although 93 percent of classrooms from the original sample were included in the main analysis, less than half (45 percent) of the original students were included. Even so, students from the two instruction groups who were included had similar characteristics before the intervention began.
